Itinerary

Departure from your hotel to the southeast area of the capital, bound for the pre-Andean town of Pirque. Arrival to this attractive town that today is practically integrated into the capital. In Pirque, the famous Viña Concha y Toro stands out. We will arrive on time to start a tour that will take us to a barracks where all the vines sold by this vineyard are present as an exhibition and learning, where we will receive an interesting explanatory talk and its neighboring palace, to understand the life that was generated in this place, associated with the production of wines. Later tour of its cellars to see the current and modern winemaking processes. We will also have the opportunity to learn something about its history, visiting the famous and ancient winery where the devil himself supposedly lives, from where the famous "Casillero del Diablo Wine" emerges, an iconic wine that is known worldwide and is wrapped in a whole story and legend that its owner started to run, to avoid the theft of his Premium wines and that to this day excites and surprises.

We conclude this visit with a wine tasting, with the imposing setting of the beautiful vineyards in the Valley and the Andes Mountains, as a mute witness to the change that the landscape has undergone over the years. Return to Santiago with a brief tour of this rural area that still maintains forgotten traditions of Chilean agriculture. Arrival in the capital directly to the hotel. End of this excursion
