Wine Route of Colchagua Valley and Santa Cruz Program

Duration: 2 Days / 01 Night

Operative: Thursday to Sunday

Itinerary

Day 01:

Departure from your hotel along Route 5 South or the Pan-American Highway, which connects our country from the distant and northern City of Arica to the city of Puerto Montt with approximately 3,100 kilometers. We will travel through the central area of the country, also called the "Huasa Zone", we will pass through the Historic City of Rancagua and San Fernando, to enter the Colchagua Valley, which Forbes Magazine named a few years ago as the second Napa Valley. This area developed in the production of wines by the hundreds saw an unusual flourishing in the 90's, where forgotten vineyards and other modern ones began to stand out, which allowed the development of a tourist activity in the area around wine. Modern vineyards with their large processes and other boutique ones were created, hotels and museums such as Colchagua in Santa Cruz arrived, a true national pride for its important and profound sample, which today has it as one of the good and outstanding museums of the country, historical and natural cut.

Route 5 South will take us to deviate and travel through local roads where the landscape presents vineyards, hills and native nature. We will arrive directly at the town of Lolol where we will visit the Viña Santa Cruz, perhaps one of the most complete, entertaining and diverse in the region. First, we will take a tour of its modern facilities to also taste its most outstanding wines such as the "Chaman" that bears its name from a nearby hill. In this vineyard we will also have the opportunity to visit the Automobile Museum, a curious and complete display of vintage, special and classic automobiles that perfectly complements this environment. Later we will ascend the emblematic Cerro Chaman by cable car. At its summit is the outstanding Indigenous Village or Original Peoples, a true recognition with respect to the peoples of our Latin America and Chile of course. Here is also the Cerro Chaman Amateur Astronomical Observatory, with a beautiful platform that allows you to appreciate the Valley from above, with its endless fields and hills. After our visit we will travel for about 40 minutes to the town of Santa Cruz, to stay at Hotel Plaza Santa Cruz, a must-see in the region.

In the afternoon, we suggest a visit to the important Colchagua Museum, which is located next to the Plaza Santa Cruz hotel. It is worth visiting since its exhibition leaves no one indifferent. Accommodation.

Day 02:

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest in the morning to finish visiting the Colchagua Museum or touring this picturesque town that has been reborn thanks to the tourist activity and wines that exist in the surroundings, making it a pole of local and regional development. After checking out at the hotel, we begin the return to the city of Santiago. Arrival in the capital directly to your hotel.
